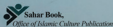

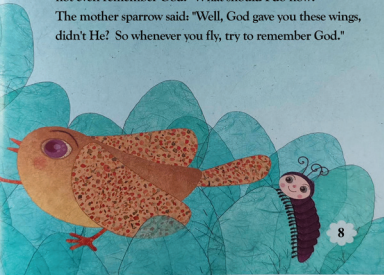








A little later, Nonuki came back and said: "I saw so many new things, but I was distracted by everything and I did not even remember God." What should I do now?"

to their expressions from behind the windows until I understood this."

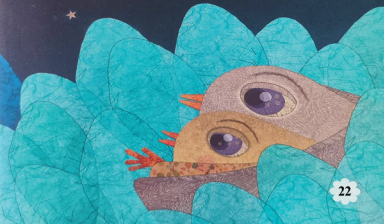




And she took her mother behind the open windows under the dome.
